

Plus/Minus Grading System

Starting with fall 2009 the University has been using a grading system that awards +/- grades (B+, A-, etc.) rather than just A, B, C, D, and F.

A	4.0
A-	3.67
B+	3.33
B	3.0
B-	2.67
C+	2.33
C	2.0
C-	1.67
D+	1.33
D	1.0
D-	0.67
F	0
